Neurodiagnostic Testing

Specialized testing helps differentiate neurological conditions from other conditions with similar symptoms and allows our staff to individualize patient treatment.

BEHAVIORAL ASSESSMENT

Clinical evaluation of existing mood or behavioral disorders centered around anxiety, PTSD, and traumatic brain injury.

TECHNOLOGY

A novel, rapidly emerging non-invasive non-pharmacologic treatment system utilizing microcurrent electrical stimulation and simultaneous real-time biofeedback applied through skin surface electrodes to individualize treatments to each patient's specific needs. This is done by continuous monitoring of heart rate variability and skin temperature gradients, while the VECT-TOR automatically customizes each patient-specific treatment. **VECTTOR**





Retrospective Study of 197 Chronic Pain Patients

- 33% reported total pain relief
- An additional 58% reported mild to significant pain reductions

- 85% reported an increase in the ability to perform activities of daily living
- 70% reported a reduction in their pain medications

What is Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS)

TMS has been recommended by the American Psychiatric Association since 2010 and FDA cleared since 2008 for the treatment of major depressive disorder.

TMS is free from common antidepressant drug side effects such as weight gain and sexual dysfunction. TMS therapy consists of repeated cycles of TMS followed by rest periods. Diagnosis and initial session is performed by a licensed physician.

TMS is non-invasive and does not require any anesthesia. As there is no recovery period, the patient can immediately return to his or her usual activities.

Transcranial magnetic stimulation (TMS) is an advanced neuromodulation technology that uses magnetic pulses to stimulate the affected areas in the brain. TMS Therapy® is an effective CE approved treatment option for patients suffering from major depressive disorder, OCD and Addiction (psychoactive substance use disorder (PSUD)). In addition, TMS Therapy can reduce the symptoms of comorbid anxiety in patients suffering from major depressive disorder.

TMS in short:

- · Series of pulsed magnetic stimuli to the brain
- Safe, with high tolerability
- Free from common antidepressant drug side effects
- Most common side effects from TMS are headache and nausea
- Does not affect cognitive function
- Patients are able to resume daily activities right after treatment
- May be used with or without antidepressants (determined by physician)
- Covered for Veterans

What does TMS feel like?

You sit in a chair in a relaxed position. When the magnetic pulses are delivered you hear a clicking sound and feel a tapping sensation on your head. Many patients are able to watch TV or read during treatment.
